GENERAL PRINCIPLES

All preemies, neonates and infants for any procedure should be preferentially assigned to a fellow or a senior resident on the pediatric rotation.

All difficult pediatric airway cases should be preferentially assigned to a fellow.

All relevant pediatric trauma particularly in infants and small children should be assigned to a fellow.
